Blueberry, boysenberry, red raspberry with hints of smoky eucalyptus and spice...all laced with white and black pepper. God damn!! A second huff required... All that, trails into rich vanilla crème brûlée and lustful thoughts

On the palate: Deep and rich flavors of forest floor and mushroom give way to with big boysenberry. Red raspberry and strawberry fruit are balanced perfectly with lively acidity woven into a graceful tannin structure. Long on the palate with hints of black fruit, vanilla, spice and the brooding finish of a woman scorned...

On the palate: Dark red and brooding mood swings of mouth-watering Zinfandel fruit, heightened with bright acid which enhance the lush crushed velvet mouth-feel that goes on and on... Brigitte Bardot is back with that gorgeous body and sexy, creamy vanilla oak finish that trails like the long lines of a woman... "Ciao Baby".

On the nose:

The nose is so dense it has a velvet texture. Boysenberry and blueberry laced with hints of lavender and rosemary, trailing into a savory crème brûlée. Drooling.... I want steak.

On the palate:

Rich red fruit married with deep blueberry. Silky tannins build around the fruit seemingly forever. Long in its story, finishes with grace and eloquence.

On the nose:

Red briar fruit, violets, and pepper laced with cream so dense it has a texture of

lanolin and then, in a moment... black cherry cola, pepper, bay leaf, clove, and provincial herb that diminish... slowly, into nothingness and everything at once... it is all about perspective.

On the palate:

Lush boysenberry fruit juxtaposed with cranberry turning to Black cherry in a dark and tragic dance lost in its adolescence, mouth-watering red fruit continues... draped in an intriguing tannic structure laced with hints of bay leaf that linger to a leathery finish wrapped in velvet oak and dark chocolate... truly a sensation.
