2012 TNT 60% Tannat 40% Cabernet Sauvignon Paso Robles

Alcohol: 15.0%
pH: 3.72
Total Acid: 0.52
Cases Produced: 240

On the nose: OMG, The Full Monty! A heavy nose full of anise, blueberry, black tea, mocha, and spice. Lush, juicy blueberry, cranberry, raspberry, and even pomegranate. ...wow!

On the palate: Notes of caramel give way to robust espresso. Amazing structure that trails into a mocha oak finish.

2012 Phoenix 50% Paso Robles Kiler Canyon Vineyard 50% Santa Barbara Co. Los Alamos Vineyard

Alcohol: .14.8%
pH: 3.65

Warm climate meets cool climate Syrah in this co-fermentation...the best of both worlds.

On the nose: The Phoenix has risen from the ashes. Gamey and smoked charcuterie infused with a touch of vanilla bean and a hint of white and black pepper.

On the palate: Bright cherry, cranberry, white pepper, bright red fruit, and boysenberry. Long on the palate trailing to a creamy subtle oak finish.



2011 Mourvedre Paso Robles

Alcohol: 14.8%
pH: 3.85
Total Acid: 0.58
Cases Produced: 303

On the nose: It's bombastic cherry that climbs out of the glass... with hints of nutmeg and cinnamon and a touch of leather.

On the palate: Bright cherries and pie filling fruits. Laced with the touch of the dirty Frenchman and black licorice... The chalky tannin structure leads into a lingering oak finish.



2012 Kiler Canyon 64% Syrah / 35% Mourvedre Paso Robles

Alcohol: 15.1%
pH: 3.88
Total Acid: 0.48
Cases Produced: 249

On the nose: Dark berry fruit laced with a hint of game. Co-mingled with blackberry, winter spices, vanilla, mocha and a touch of oak.

On the palate: Chocolate, cherry, bright red berry fruit, rhubarb, and spice. A big curvy mouthfeel that trails into forever crème brûlée.
